

Solver: Resolve articles to the URL in the catalog rather than the DOI

Some journals do not have DOIs for all articles. Others have DOIs that go to a paywall site while the article is free elsewhere. For example, *Indian Pediatrics*, 0974-755, has both of these problems. Without CyberTools special purpose programming for these titles, the best option is to resolve the article to the journal's homepage and hope that the searcher navigates to the article.
